It is necessary to present copy of birth certificate and copy of the Minor Identity Card of the shareholder, in case the shares had been acquired in force of said documents.

The power of attorney must be filled with the complete information of both parents, and be signed by them.

The agent must appear at the extraordinary meeting of the Assembly with an identification document, either a:

- For Colombian nationals, the Colombian citizenship ID (CC (yellow card with holograms)) or temporary identity card.

- For Foreigners, the Colombian Alien ID or their passport.

This power of attorney does not require to be notarized.

The shareholder can use the template that is published on the website in order to indicate or set forth the direction of the vote for the motions on the agenda subject to be voted.
